## CAWP Showcases Future Road Builders Apprenticeship Readiness Course at Build On 2024 Event



On Friday, November 1, CAWP showcased the Future Road Builders <u>Apprenticeship Readiness Course</u> at the 2024 Build On Event hosted by the Builders Guild of Western Pennsylvania at the David L. Lawrence Convention Center. Approximately 2,800 students from area school districts and career and technical centers attended.

CAWP members Mascaro Construction, Mosites Construction Company, Swank Construction Company and Trumbull Corporation also participated in the event to speak with students about construction careers. Representatives from the Laborers, Operating Engineers, Carpenters and Cement Masons provided students with hands-on demonstrations, and apprenticeship and career information.

Pennsylvania Governor Josh Shapiro addressed the group of students about the importance of construction workers to the economy, and ensuring the future construction workforce.
