Protect Construction from OSHA's One-Size-Fits-All Heat Rule

The Occupational Safety and Health Administration's (OSHA) is trying to arbitrarily adopt a one-size-fits-all national heat standard that's triggered when the heat index exceeds 80°F as part of its new Heat Safety Rule.

Using a one-size-fits-all heat standard creates impractical requirements and leaves employers vulnerable to citations and penalties.

Your help is needed- tell OSHA its final rule must recognize regional differences in climate and account for workers' behavior and individual health conditions that could put construction employers at increased risk.
