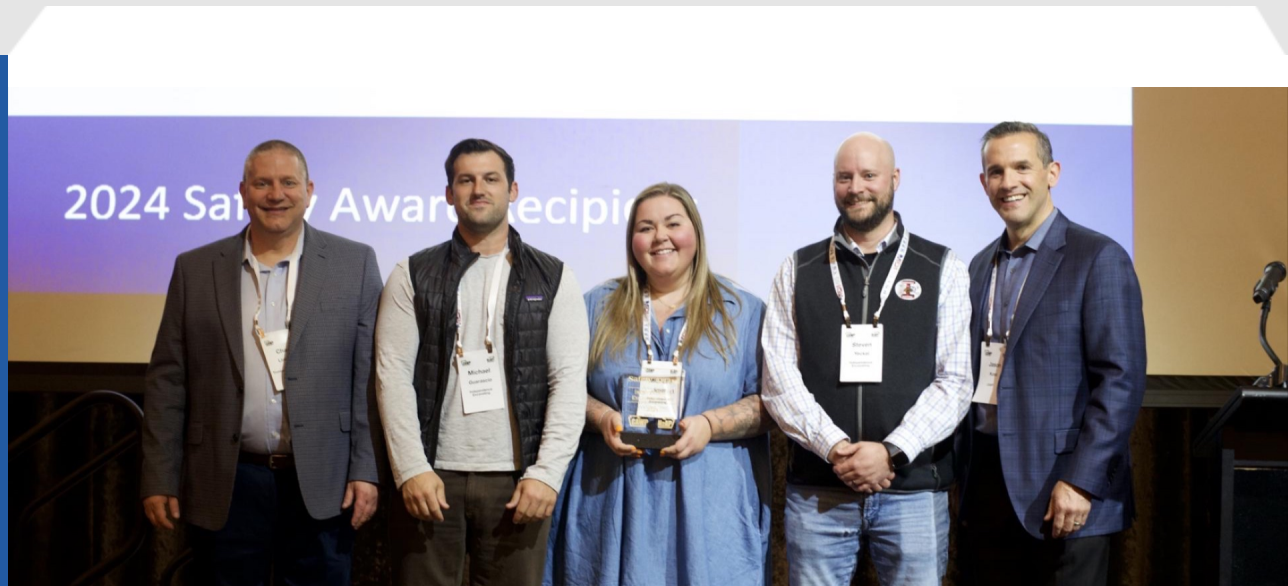

On April 3, 2025, the CAWP Safety Committee held its latest meeting at MSA, The Safety Company, in Cranberry Township, PA. More than 20 committee members

attended the event, which included a full agenda of safety discussions, an insightful presentation, and an exclusive tour.

The meeting began with committee agenda items including a CAWP/OSHA Alliance update by OSHA representative Bob Carroll, followed by a presentation on Pitt IRISE's research project, the AI Safety Assistant. This initiative explores how artificial intelligence can enhance safety measures in the construction industry. After a working lunch, attendees toured MSA's Ryan Labs, where they observed firsthand how safety equipment is tested to meet industry standards.

The visit provided committee members with valuable insights into safety technology, products, and equipment and reinforced CAWP's commitment to fostering a culture of safety in the highway construction industry.

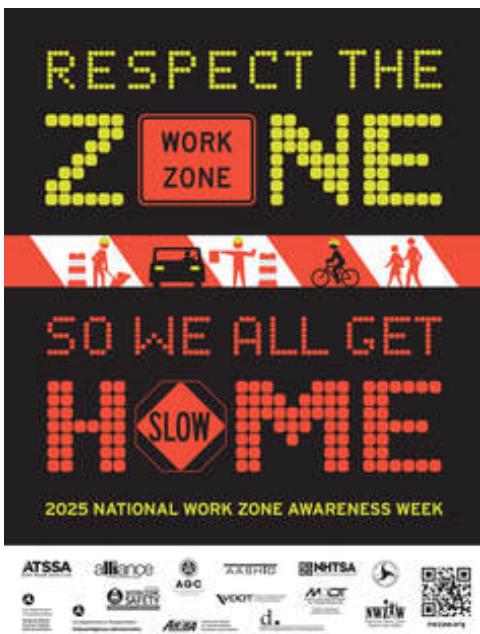


Plan Ahead: National Work Zone Awareness Week is April 21-25
